The Soulpepper Academy is 26-week training program that aims to develop highly skilled theatre artists who are equipped to make significant contributions in rehearsal halls and to the cultural landscape of Canada. Following the program's re-launch in 2021 under Soulpepper Artistic Director Weyni Mengesha's leadership, the Academy has prioritized an inclusive and care-based approach to artistic training.

This year's Academy focused on musical storytelling and creation. Academy members were chosen for their unique musical talent and their skills as collaborators in musical creation and performance.

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
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
