





# KIM'S CONVENIENCE

When my kids were born, I introduced myself to them as 'Appa'. Now they're teenagers and when they do call me, they still call me 'Appa'. For me, the sound of that word invites feelings of games, stories, humour, adventure and curiosity. I hope my kids'll say the same one day.

Having originated the role of Jung (the son) almost fifteen years ago, I'm grateful to now be playing the role of Appa (the dad) in this play. My kids have been preparing me for this their whole lives.

My Appa turns 90 this year. I love him. During the Korean war, my Appa and his siblings walked from the north to the south in search of a new start. In 1975, my parents came to Canada with two hundred dollars, three kids and a ferocious amount of hope. We lived with my uncle's family in Toronto above their convenience store called 'Kim's Grocer'. After this play's premiere at the 2011 Toronto Fringe Festival, my Appa and Umma hugged me and said, "We are very proud of you. Thank you.". This play is a love letter to them and to all first-generation immigrants who end up making a foreign land, home.






